## Kitchen Towel Ring

## What you need


$\sim 15 y d(14 \mathrm{M})$ size 4 worsted weight yarn cotton or acrylic
~Hook Size 5mm H-8
~Scissors
~Yarn needle
$\sim$ Button 3/4in ( 2 cm )
$\sim$ Sewing thread and needle
~Hair tie

## Stitch Legend

R- row
ST(s)- stitch(s)
CH(s)- Chain(s)
SLST- slip stitch
DC- Double crochet

## Notes

This is a nice little ring that holds your kitchen towel to the oven handle. Its design allows you to change out your towel and it works up really fast.

## Pattern

This first row is worked around the hair tie to give the towel a place to hang.
R1- SLST around hair tie CH3 then DC all the way around the hair tie until it is compleatly covered. SLST to close. Aprox. 40 ST

R2- CH3 DC2 in same ST CH2 skip 1 ST 3DC all in same ST
R3- Turn your work and SLST to CH2 space 3DC CH2 3DC all in CH 2 space

Repeat R3 6 more times then cut and tie off yarn

Weave in any ends
Sew on your button at the base of the tail on your ring.
