

Kitchen Towel Ring

PDF Pattern

What you need



- ~ 15yd (14M) size 4 worsted weight yarn cotton or acrylic
- ~ Hook Size 5mm H-8
- ~ Scissors
- ~ Yarn needle
- ~ Button 3/4in (2cm)
- ~ Sewing thread and needle
- ~ Hair tie

Stitch Legend

- R- row
- ST(s)- stitch(s)
- CH(s)- Chain(s)
- SLST- slip stitch
- DC- Double crochet

Notes

This is a nice little ring that holds your kitchen towel to the oven handle. Its design allows you to change out your towel and it works up really fast.

Pattern

This first row is worked around the hair tie to give the towel a place to hang.

R1- SLST around hair tie CH3 then DC all the way around the hair tie until it is completely covered. SLST to close. Aprox. 40 ST

R2- CH3 DC2 in same ST CH2 skip 1 ST 3DC all in same ST

R3- Turn your work and SLST to CH2 space 3DC CH2 3DC all in CH 2 space

Repeat R3 6 more times then cut and tie off yarn

Weave in any ends

Sew on your button at the base of the tail on your ring.

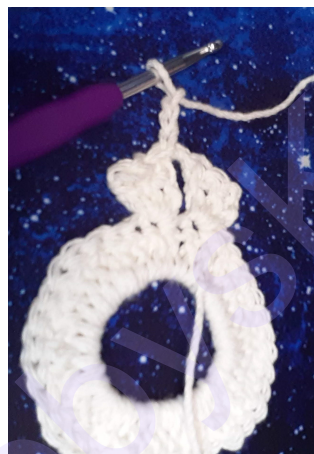
